

**Madison Arts Barn
COVID & ILLNESS Policies
Applicable to Everyone Including, but Not Limited to,
Employees, Volunteers and Participants
Updated March 3, 2022**

1. Entry Policy:

- a. If you have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last ten days
 - i. Regardless of vaccination status you may not enter the Barn for at least 5 days from testing positive or not until you are fever-free* for at least 24 hrs, whichever is later. Upon return to The Barn you must wear a mask at all times through day 10. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test before returning.
- b. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed or suspected to have COVID-19. Close Contact is being within 6 feet of someone for a total of 15 minutes in a 24 hours period.
 - i. If you are fully vaccinated you can enter the building but will need to wear a mask for 10 days from exposure. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test or a PCR test 5 days after exposure.
 - ii. If you are unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated you may not enter the Barn for at least 5 days from exposure. Upon return to The Barn you must wear a mask at all times through day 10. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test or a PCR test 5 days after exposure.
- c. If you have had a fever* of 100.4F or vomited in the last 24 hours you may not enter the building.

2. Masks: Masks are recommended, except under the following conditions you will be required to wear a mask:

- a. If you are experiencing a cough or cold like symptoms;
- b. if you have tested positive for Covid within the last 10 days; or
- c. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed or suspected to have COVID-19.

3. Vaccinations: Proof of Vaccination OR a Negative PCR test result may be required for certain events. Advance notice will be given.

* A temperature of greater than 100.4 without the use of fever reducing medications.
