

**Madison Arts Barn  
COVID & ILLNESS Policies  
Applicable to Everyone Including, but Not Limited to,  
Employees, Volunteers and Participants  
Updated September 10, 2022**

**1. Entry Policy:**

- a. All entrants will be asked if they have any cold or COVID symptoms or have been exposed to anyone who has tested positive for COVID. If they answer yes to any of the questions they will be asked to wear a mask.
- b. If you have tested positive for COVID-19 within the last ten days
  - i. Regardless of vaccination status you may not enter the Barn for at least 5 days from testing positive or not until you are fever-free\* for at least 24 hrs, whichever is later. Upon return to The Barn you must wear a mask at all times through day 10. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test before returning.
- c. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed to have COVID.
  - i. You can enter the building but will need to wear a mask for 10 days from exposure. It is strongly recommended to take an “at home” antigen test or a PCR test 5 days after exposure.
- d. If you have had a fever\* of 100.4F or vomited in the last 24 hours you may not enter the building.

**2. Masks:** Masks are not required, except under the following conditions you will need to wear a mask:

- a. If you are experiencing any COVID or cold like symptoms;
- b. if you have tested positive for COVID within the last 10 days; or
- c. If you have been in close contact with someone who has been confirmed to have COVID.

**3. Vaccinations:** Proof of Vaccination OR a Negative PCR test result may be required for certain events. Advance notice will be given.

\* A temperature of greater than 100.4 without the use of fever reducing medications.
